

Making an Appointment at Access PT

Access Physical Therapists and staff look forward to serving you. Under normal circumstances, you should not have to wait more than 2 days for an appointment.

It is necessary and helpful to have spoken to your primary physician or treating physician about physical therapy, and that you receive a prescription for medical necessity before you visit us. Our interdisciplinary approach to rehabilitation will likely cause us to communicate with them regularly regarding your treatment plan.

The following documents will be **required** at your first appointment.

- ✓ Physical Therapy Prescription or Written Referral
- ✓ Driver's License or valid state picture ID
- ✓ Current Insurance cards and information
- ✓ Copies of MRI, X-rays, and CT scans, or diagnostic films, disks and reports
- ✓ A complete list of all the medications you're taking at every visit
- ✓ Your co-pay. ***We accept Visa, MasterCard, and Discover***
- ✓ Completed registration forms usually sent to you in advance of your appointment and available on this website in downloadable files.

We recognize that your time is valuable and make every effort to run on time. In an effort to meet the needs of each patient completely, we occasionally run behind schedule and appreciate your patience during these delays.

If you need to cancel your appointment please call us during business hours at least 24 hours in advance of your appointment. Appointments **not** cancelled by telephone in advance will be subject to a processing fee at the time of your next appointment.
